




1. Make sure all pop up blockers are turned off in your browser.

From the “lobby” you can choose what room you would like to go to:

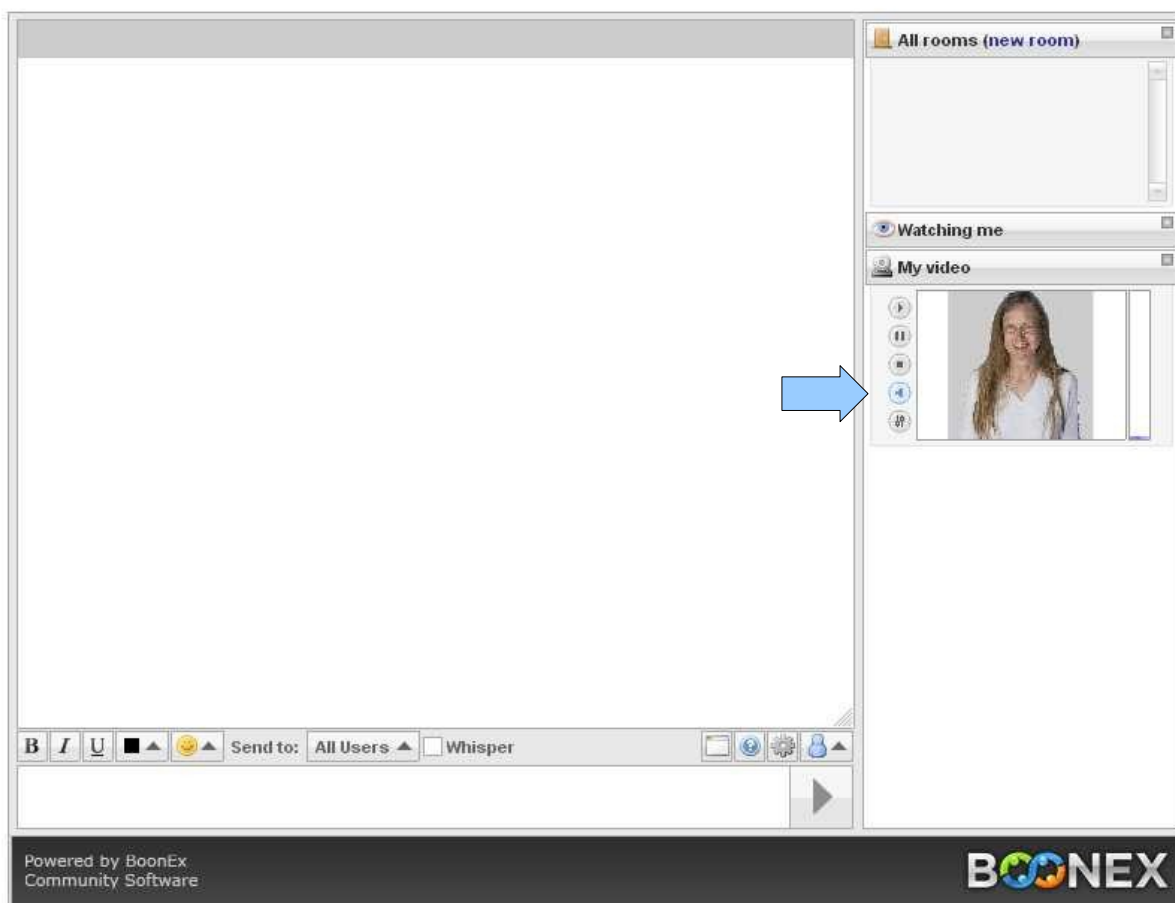
Find the “all rooms” block (above your picture on the bottom right) and notice the door to the right of the rooms you can choose from

When you enter the room, on your picture (bottom right) there is a small triangle on the left (second symbol from bottom) this is to “cast audio” (turns your audio on) click on that.




This is a flash chat that will pop up a request for “theawakenet.org” to have access to your mic and camera...

Answer “Allow” to be able to audio/video chat.

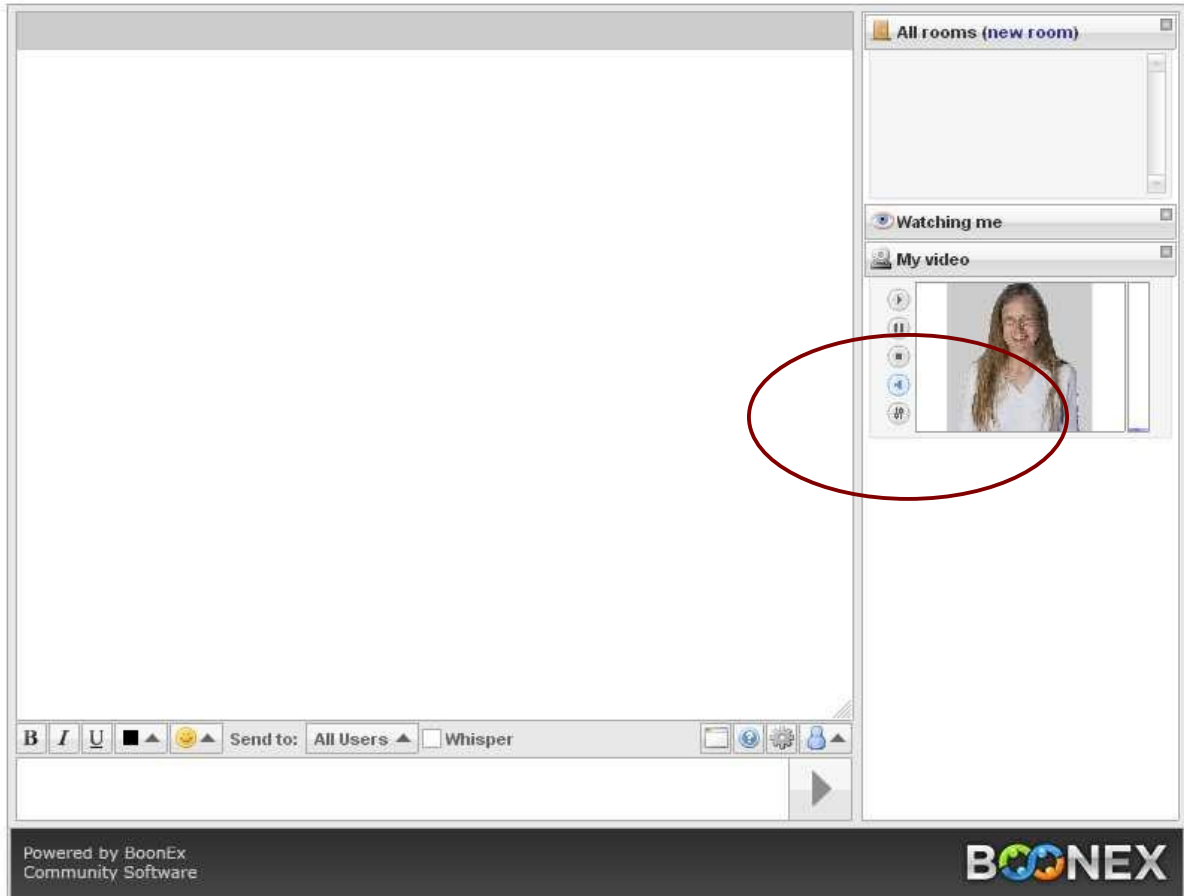

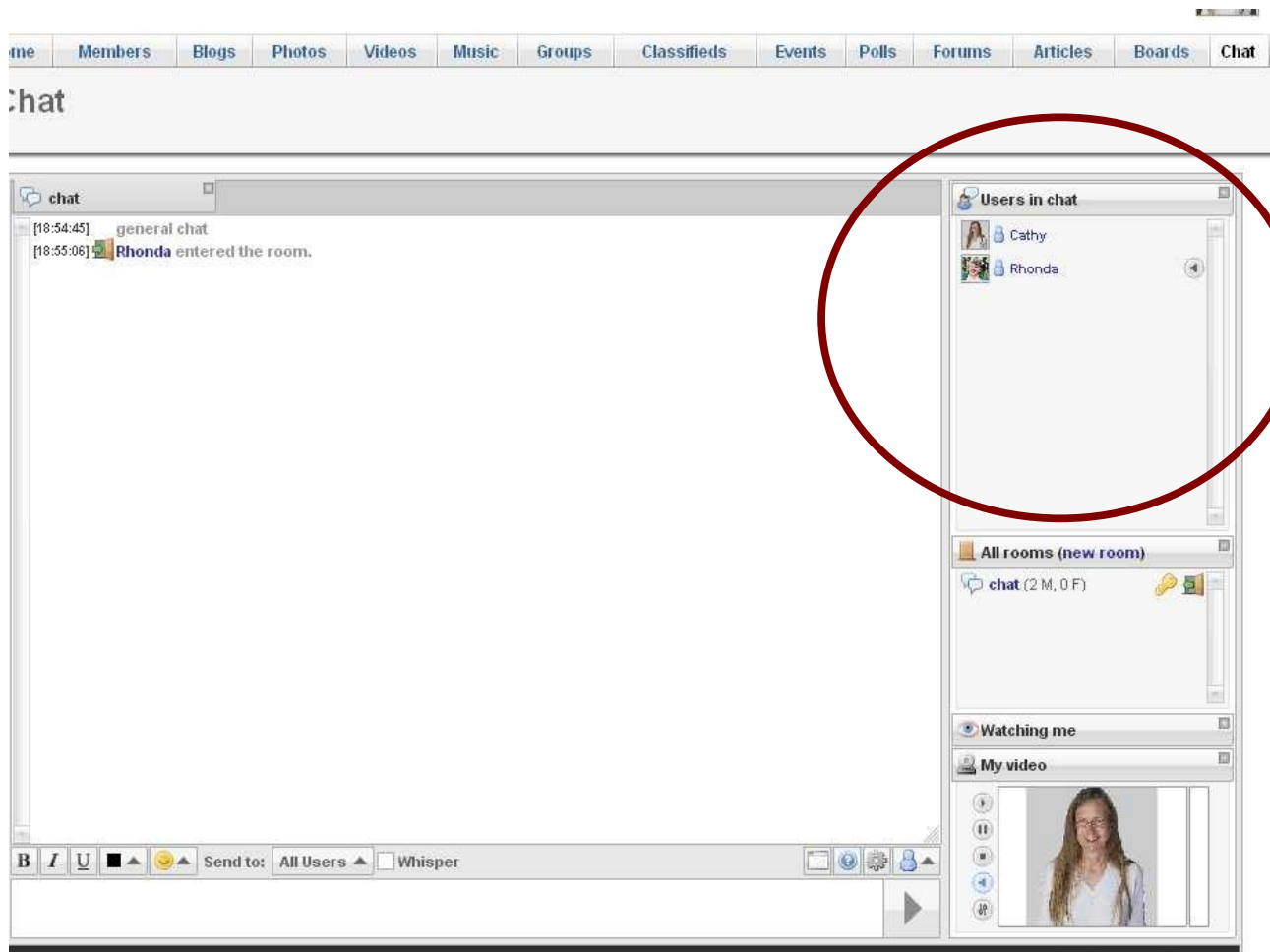

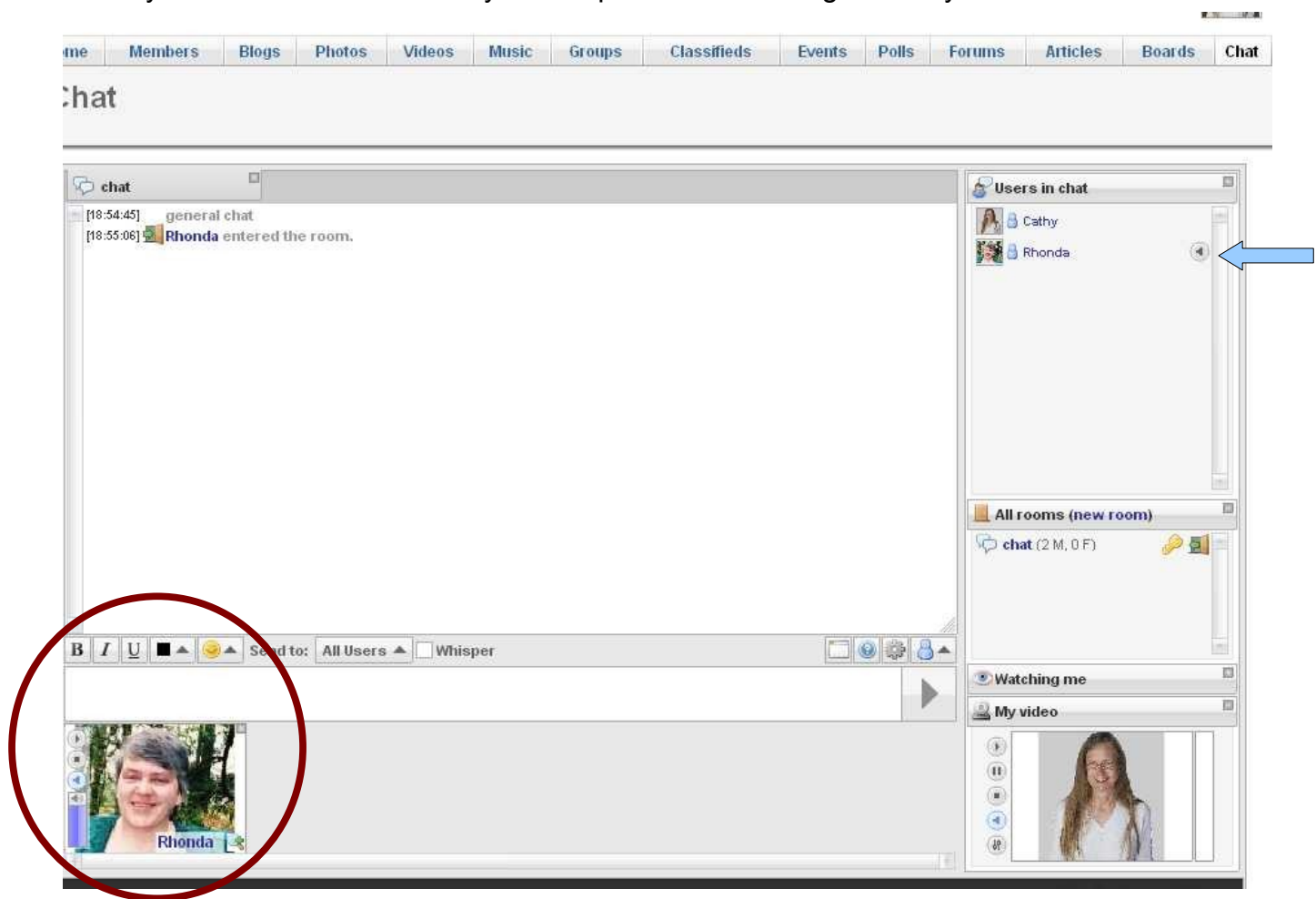
